Artists' Advocate Program

- \$50,000 Underwrites expenses for a Main Stage non-musical production
- \$25,000 Underwrites expenses for cast of a Main Stage play or Theatre School Season
- \$10,000 Underwrites expenses for a Main Stage Director or a Theatre School Musical
- \$5,000 Underwrites an Equity Actor or a Theatre School Play
- \$2,500 Underwrites expenses for one Main Stage performance
- \$2,000 Underwrites expenses for a non-union Actor or a Choreographer
- \$1,000 Underwrites props or costumes for a Main Stage production
- \$500 Underwrites a Dialect Coach, Wig Designer, or a Theatre School Actor Mentor
- \$250 Underwrites expenses for a Behind the Mask educational outreach session
