**SIR ALAN AYCKBOURN** (Playwright) 2017 marks the 60th anniversary of Alan Ayckbourn joining the Library Theatre Company in Scarborough, of which he was the Artistic Director for 37 years. He has spent his life in theatre, rarely if ever tempted by television or film, which perhaps explains why he continues to be so prolific. To date he has written 82 plays - the 81st premiering this summer. His work has been translated into over 35 languages, is performed on stage and television throughout the world and has won countless awards. Major successes include: *Relatively Speaking, How the Other Half Loves, Absurd Person Singular, Bedroom Farce, A Chorus of Disapproval* and The *Norman Conquests*. In recent years, there have been revivals of *Season's Greetings* and *A Small Family Business* at the National Theatre and in the West End productions of *Absent Friends, Relatively Speaking* and *How The Other Half Loves*. He has been inducted into American Theatre's Hall of Fame, received the 2010 Critics' Circle Award for Services to the Arts and became the first British playwright to receive both Olivier and Tony Special Lifetime Achievement Awards. He was knighted in 1997 for 'services to theatre.'
