ERIC PFEFFINGER (Playwright) is a member of the Dramatists Guild and the Writers Guild of America East. His plays have been produced by the Humana Festival of New American Plays at Actors Theatre of Louisville, the Denver Theatre Center, the Geva Theatre Center, the Phoenix Theatre, the InterAct, and elsewhere. He's written new plays on commissions from the Signature Theatre, the InterAct, Imagination Stage, and the Bloomington Playwrights Project.
